

Odds are if you have stopped by Eastside anytime in the past year, you have noticed that we are running out of space! WE ARE BLESSED!

Our hope is to start our "Clothing Bank" Building project the end of this Summer, early Fall.

Our free Clothing Bank provides gently used/new clothing, small household items, shoes, blankets, hats, gloves, scarves, and toys to individuals in need. We currently have a very small Clothing Bank with limited space for people to shop for what they need and have donations for the Clothing Bank stored in four different locations. Due to limited space we have had to utilize our partnerships with churches and store items for our special projects off site. This makes it very difficult to inventory. Having the new building will allow us to have everything in one location. The building will be 40' x 70' and will house both where donations are dropped off and where our neighbor's shop. The building will be located directly across from Eastside Community Ministry and will be open to anyone in need of assistance.

This extra space will help us be able to sort and inventory items much easier and help individuals shopping find what they are looking for. This will also help us store out of season items.

In 2021, we provided 75,000 items to neighbors in need. In 2021, we received Clothing Bank donations valuing \$243,776.15.

Many people from different walks of life visit our Clothing Bank. We serve individuals who are without homes, single mothers, single fathers, grandparents, elderly, domestic violence survivors, fire victims, people job searching or newly employed, folks who are entering Sober Living or going to a Rehab facility, and restored citizens. Many guardians shop in our Clothing Bank for Christmas and Birthday presents.

Our Clothing Bank also provides clothing for many kids to start the school year. A few years ago, we started doing a "Back to School" clothing giveaway and in 2021 we were able to combine this project with our "Lace Up for Kids" project and provide each child with a brand-new outfit, underwear, socks, and shoes. Every child should start their first day feeling confident and ready to take on the school year. We were able to help over 800 kids through this project.

In 2021, we were able to bless over 400 children with Christmas presents. We also have other special projects such as: Tools for Schools, Operation Warm, Outreach Projects, and Produce Markets.

By expanding and adding this additional building it will not only help us better serve individuals through our Clothing Bank, but it will also open up other space to allow us to better serve individuals through our Food Pantry, Back to School programs, and other special projects.
